Texture is an element of art.

Real TEXTURE

When an object feels just as it looks. It looks bumpy & feels bumpy when you touch it.

Example: a tree that you can touch.



Implied TEXTURE

When an object looks bumpy, yet it is actually smooth. It has the illusion of being something that it is not. *Example*: a photo of a tree.
