


Read Revelation 1:1-19.


**Read Revelation 4:1-11**


I watched as the Lamb broke open the first of the seven seals.

Then I heard one of the four living creatures say in a voice that sounded like thunder, "Come!"


After this I saw four angels. They were standing at the four corners of the earth.

Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying




**CHALLENGE:** Finish drawing the lamb's body and design a background for him. Glue cotton balls onto his body to make a wooly coat if you wish.



The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean.


Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations.

# The Rider on the White Horse



John 3:16-18, **John 3:36**, John 14:6, **Acts 4:12**


Talk to an adult about what you read.



Revelation 22:1-5

Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.

No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him. They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads. There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. And they will reign for ever and ever.
