


Read Revelation 4:1-11


I watched as the Lamb broke open the first of the seven seals.






CHALLENGE:

Draw a picture on the banners above to describe what happened when each angel blew his trumpet.





CHALLENGE: Decorate this crown. Heaven is a very special place.


